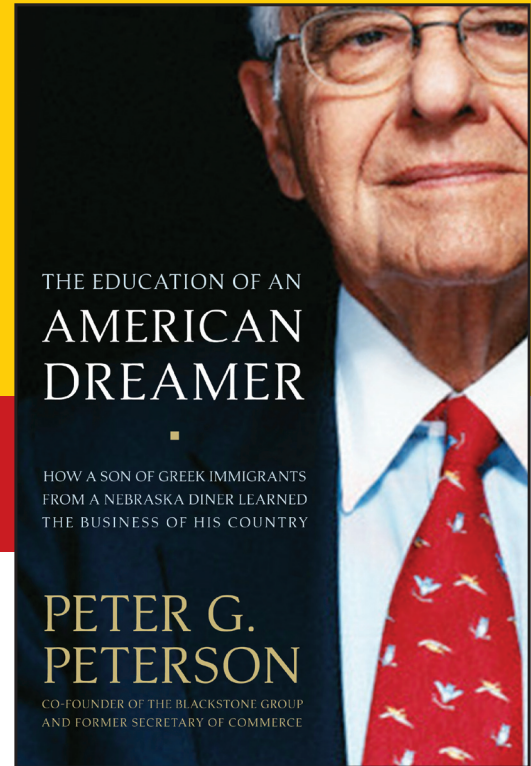

Scenes from his remarkable life include:

- ★ His days as a marketing whiz and “Mad Man” in Chicago, where he became a Vice President of McCann-Erickson at the age of 27.
- ★ His recruitment into the Nixon Administration to be the “economic Kissinger,” his time as Secretary of Commerce, and his view of Nixon’s fall in the wake of Watergate.
- ★ His sudden elevation to Chairman and CEO of Lehman Brothers in 1973 (as the firm was on the brink of collapse), his battles with a poisonous corporate culture, his successful turnaround from significant operating losses to record profits, and his abrupt departure.
- ★ His decision in 1985 to co-found The Blackstone Group, a private investment banking firm that became a galvanizing force in capitalism, elevating Peterson to his current phase in life—billionaire philanthropist.
- ★ His latest venture, The Peter G. Peterson Foundation, dedicated to targeting the undeniable, unsustainable, and untouchable threats to the nation’s future.

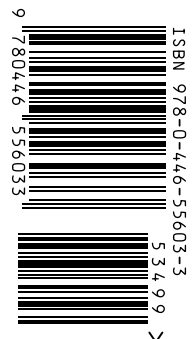
