

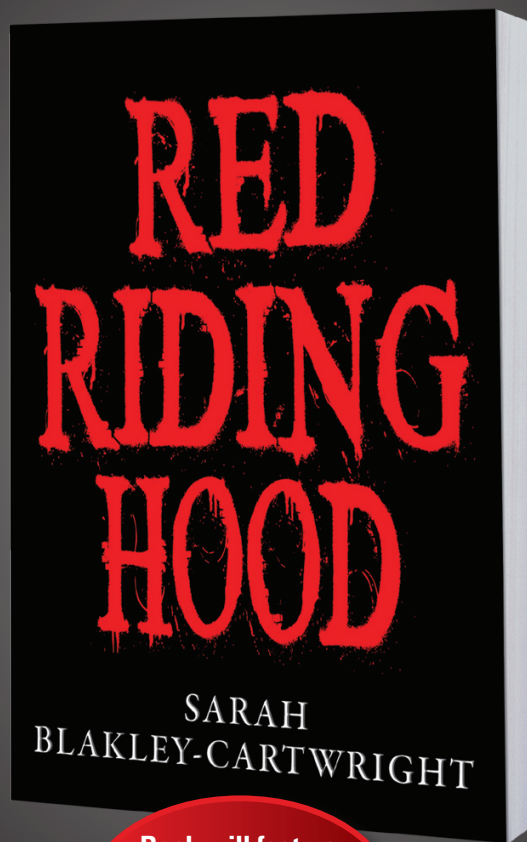
*Twilight* director CATHERINE HARDWICKE brings a gothic twist to the classic tale of Red Riding Hood.
